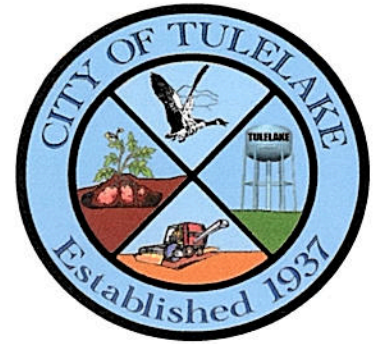

WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT

The City of Tulelake had its ribbon cutting ceremony on November 15, 2016, at the Wastewater Treatment Facility on Dean Callis Way in Tulelake. The occasion marked the conclusion of a long process to get the facility upgraded and back in compliance with the State so we could remove the current Cease and Desist order.

Mayor Hank Ebinger, and Director of Public Works, Brett Nystrom had the honors of cutting the ribbon. Also in attendance was Grant Manager, Jim Cook, and Jeremy Morris, along with several staff members who worked on the project, from Adkins Engineering. Council members Randy Darrow and Kevin Nicholson made an appearance along with Jenny Coelho, City Administrative Clerk for the City of Tulelake.

After the ceremony, refreshments were served at City Hall. Brett Nystrom presented a plaque to Jeremy Morris for the excellent work and commitment given to the City of Tulelake on this project.

CHRISTMAS TREE LIGHTING

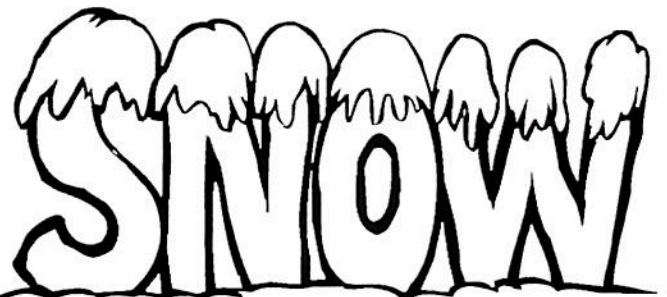

for your favorite tree! Be on the lookout for Santa! He might be there too!

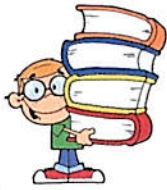
ELECTION RESULTS
